

Disability Accommodations Appeals Processes

Roger Williams University (RWU) is committed to providing reasonable accommodations to students with documented disabilities. Consistent with applicable law, RWU determines disability accommodation requests through an interactive process involving its disability services professionals in Student Accessibility Services (SAS), appropriate members of the University community, the requesting students, and others.

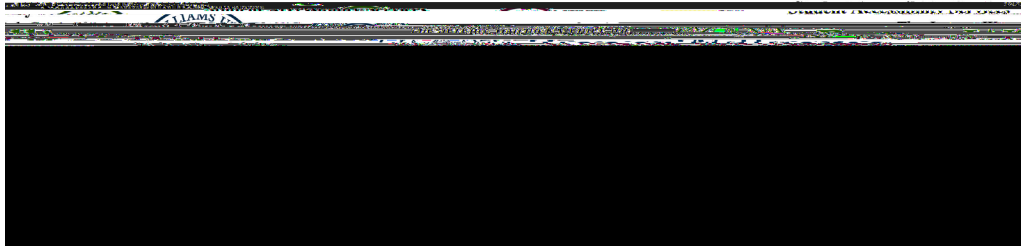
As part of this process, a student may disagree about the appropriateness of an accommodation decision. In many cases, additional dialogue between the parties and/or additional information may resolve some disagreements and result in prompt, reasonable solutions. However, in some instances, students occasionally may disagree with decisions made by Student Accessibility Services (SAS) regarding the reasonableness of requested accommodations and may informally appeal these decisions to SAS. SAS will work with the student to try to resolve any concerns. If

twenty (20) business days of the submission of the written appeal. If a student remains unsatisfied with the result of the informal appeals process, then they may submit a formal appeal to RWU's Section 504 Coordinator.

Formal Appeals Process

Students may appeal the denial of an accommodation request by SAS, after the informal appeals

documentation). By submitting an appeal, the appealing student authorizes the release of their accommodation-related health information to the Section 504 Coordinator (or designee). Please note that student health information will not be shared beyond what is necessary to process the appeal.



Upon receipt of the appeal, the Section 504 Coordinator, or designee, will review all relevant information
